

## ASIAN-PACIFIC CONGRESS ON THE MANAGEMENT OF HIV INFECTION

BANGKOK, THAILAND 19-23 JUNE 1995

The Asian-Pacific Congress on the Management of HIV Infection – the first scientific meeting of its kind in this region – will take place at the Bangkok Convention Centre, Central Plaza Hotel Complex, Bangkok, Thailand, from 19-23 June 1995.



This meeting will focus on the clinical management and treatment of HIV Infection, particularly from an Asian-Pacific perspective, within a scientific programme structured around a series of non-competing, whole audience sessions. It is intended that this should lead to the development of constructive therapeutic guidelines. Plenary lectures will be presented by acknowledged experts in the field of HIV research and therapy. 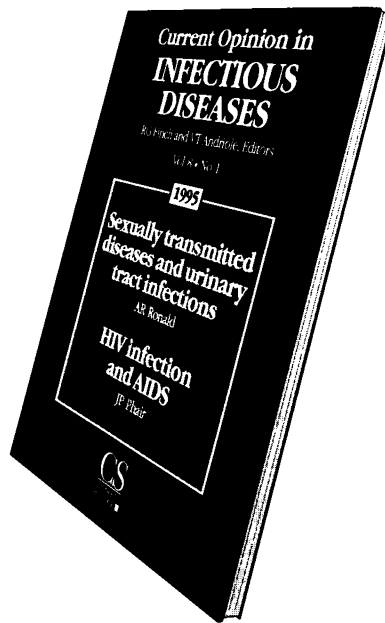
