Before you print your lab form, there are a few things we want to make sure you understand about STI testing. Read each statement carefully and check the box beside it to confirm you understand. You must check all the boxes to get your lab form.

- I understand that I can get more information before I get tested. [More](#)
- I understand that getting tested is voluntary. [More](#)
- I know what STI tests I am getting. I understand that the recommended tests require a urine sample for chlamydia and gonorrhoea, and a blood sample for syphilis, HIV and hepatitis C. If the test is done too soon, it may not be able to detect the infection and I will need to be retested after the 'window period' for each STI. I understand that GetCheckedOnline does not offer all the STI tests I might get if I went to an STI clinic.

- I know a nurse will contact me if my test results show that I have an STI. [More](#)
